Description:

We are looking to add a friendly, talented educator who believes in play-based education to join our team in mid-August for the 2021-2022 school year. The ideal candidate will demonstrate integrity, organization, a love of children and a strong sense of professional responsibility. Our new educator will have a high level of energy, love of learning, and can manage multiple tasks and priorities. We are looking for a colleague that has the ability to work effectively and cooperatively with others, communicate tactfully with children, parents, faculty and staff members.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Plan and Implement developmentally appropriate Science activities for 2 years through Kindergarten
- Collaborate with classroom teachers to meet the needs of each classroom
- Teach classes of 12-18 children with 1-2 additional teachers
- Maintain communication with classroom families through email, classroom blogs, and Kaymbu

Requirements-required and preferred qualifications for a teacher position:

- PDIS Level 3 credential required
- Required to have either an Early Childhood Teacher (ECT) qualification or Colorado Early Childhood Teaching License
- BA or BS highly preferred
